

# Information for underage students applying to a Bachelor's program in their home region

Bachelor's programs with restricted admission

## Underage applicants

The sole criterion for the allocation of study places within the underage student quota is the grade average of the Higher Education Entrance Qualification (HEEQ).

### Requirements:

To apply under the underage student quota you must meet the following requirements:

- at the time of application your main place of residence must be in the same household as your parent(s)/legal guardian(s) and close to the institution of higher education you are applying to.
- at the official beginning of the lecture period (<https://www.th-koeln.de/calender>) you must be under 18 years of age (i.e. you must be underage on this date).

### Home region

The following districts (*Kreise*) and towns are considered to be close to TH Köln's individual sites:

Cologne:

- Cologne, Leverkusen, Rhein-Erft-Kreis, Mettmann, Neuss, Rheinisch Bergischer Kreis, Rhein-Sieg-Kreis.

Gummersbach:

- Remscheid, Wuppertal, Ennepe-Ruhr-Kreis, Märkischer Kreis, Oberbergischer Kreis, Olpe, Rheinisch Bergischer Kreis, Rhein-Sieg-Kreis, Altenkirchen (Rhineland-Palatinate).

Leverkusen:

- Cologne, Leverkusen, Mettmann, Rheinisch Bergischer Kreis

## Checklist

copy of your ID (*Personalausweis*)

Higher Education Entrance Qualification (HEEQ), e.g. *Abitur* certificate

Confirmation issued by the registration office certifying that you share a household with your parents (*Haushaltsbescheinigung*) - original document (can be requested from your local registration office (*Stadt/Gemeinde/Bezirksamt*))
